

Civic Acts: New Plays Toward The Beloved Community is Civic Ensemble's new annual play festival in Ithaca featuring new political plays by nationally and internationally renowned playwrights whose work centers women and people of color. These plays deal with the challenges our communities face in moving society toward what Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. called The Beloved Community. Civic Acts is one of the rare new play festivals in the U.S. devoted to socially-engaged theatre. The Beloved Community, first articulated by Fellowship of Reconciliation founder Josiah Royce, is a vision where all people share in the wealth of the earth.
