Dear Friends of the Hangar:

Our 49th season featured 3 incredible Mainstage productions, 4 KIDDSTUFF Theatre for Young Audiences shows (including the return of our Next Gen musical), 3 Hangar Wedge FutureNow Readings, and 23 week-long sessions of the Hangar's Next Generation School of Theatre.

Selected Audience Feedback for KIDDSTUFF and Mainstage productions included:

Our Mainstage and KIDDSTUFF Seasons reached over **8,000 audience members** with a line up of fantastic productions that delighted and awed audiences of all ages.

I'm also very happy to report: we ended 2023 with a budget in the black. After several COVID-influenced years, we—like many arts organizations in this country—have struggled to understand and adjust to new funding realities. We worked very hard to create a model for 2023 that utilized our resources in a responsible way, while still creating unique and exceptional artistic experiences for and with the community. With a memorable mainstage season that included *What the Constitution Means to Me*, *Billy Elliot*, and our *Impossible Dream Pops Concert*, we did just that.

Thank you to our patrons, our artistic community, and our many supporters—past and present—for launching us towards our 50th Season, and our landmark 50th year.

Starting in 1968, a small group of impassioned Ithaca locals worked together to turn an airplane hangar in Cass Park into a performing arts center. Thanks to the commitment of beloved Hangar community member Tom Niederkorn, and so many others, the Hangar Theatre opened its doors to the public in 1975, and Ithaca gained a home for the arts, artists, and theatre-lovers in our community. This was no small feat and took a decade of rallying for support, and the courage, love, and determination of a strong community to make it happen. That small group of locals changed our world.

For the last 49 years, the Hangar Theatre has grown into a regional theatre with national prominence, producing exceptional plays and musicals and providing learning opportunities for the next generation of rising theatre artists. The only reason the Hangar Theatre is still here today is because of every person who chose to buy a ticket or a subscription each year, thanks to foundations and sponsors who support the arts, and as a result of devoted members of our community who refuse to let the light of those founding members go dark on our treasured Hangar Theatre.

Now, more than ever, we need our community to lift us up. Theaters all over the country are having to close their doors due to financial strain, and we cannot stress enough how much your presence and support truly matter now. This year, we have minimized our staff to a small and passionate powerhouse, reduced our Mainstage Season to three fantastic and fully-resourced shows, and made a conscious effort to use our resources to sustain a high-quality theatre experience for our audiences, artists, and production teams. With the help of federal funding, we navigated the challenges of the pandemic, and **now we need to rely solely on outreach to bring audiences, funds, and support back to the theatre to keep us growing strong.**

We believe in the power of theatre to transform lives, and we have seen the potential of our community's power. It is the very reason the Hangar Theatre exists today. Your presence truly is a gift to theatre. Every ticket sale, subscription, donation, sponsorship, and grant helps to support the costs of producing exceptional high-quality theatre for you, your family, and our community and helps to make educational opportunities here accessible to everyone who wishes to participate. We hope you will continue to fill our seats by bringing friends, seeing shows, and spreading the word to those you love. ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The Hangar Theatre's programs reach young people and emerging artists ages six to adult, with the intention of nurturing empathetic and thoughtful relationships and interactions between people by making space for collaboration and communication in the artistic process; helping individuals of all ages to express their most authentic and joyful selves through theatre, music, and movement. We aim to support artistic choices that embrace a diversity of perspectives and promote attitudes and actions that encourage more equitable power, access, and treatment for all.

In 2023 our education programming allowed us to:

- Welcome **over 275 young people** into Next Generation School of Theatre class sessions that celebrated their imagination and individuality.
- Award **over \$7000 in need-based scholarships** to young participants
- Produce **5 KIDDSTUFF Theatre for Young Audience Productions**, attended by **over 2850 audience members**.
- Bring Project 4 Arts-in-the-Classroom Residencies into **3 school districts, 9 schools, and 28 individual classrooms**, reaching approximately **500 students and 40 classroom educators**.
