We will open the doors and walk into the lobby.



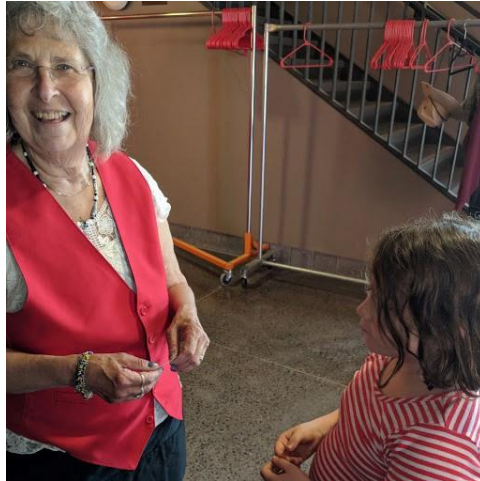
We can go to the box office to pick up our tickets. Our tickets might have a seat number on them, telling us where to sit. If not we get to choose our own seats.
